September 23, 2009 Meeting – AABS Club Auction.

This was the evening of the annual auction, the first in years without Roger and Donna Gaede. Those who planned to sell bonsai and related items were slow to arrive, not until well after 7 PM. President Bill Heston brought the meeting to order promptly at 7:30 PM. There were only a few matters to discuss and they were dispensed with quickly. There was a reminder of the field trip to Gee Farms with Jack Wikle scheduled for

October 10 and a brief discussion of the Annual Show.

Members of the executive board carried out preparation for and the administration of the auction. John Parks provided the auctioneering service that began at 7:40 PM and continued until 9:15 PM. He was able to handle the bonsai and related items of 10 sellers. Nearly \$900 in sales was transacted among 21 purchasers. Two members donated all their auction earnings to the Society; one was Ken Huth, a vendor at our annual show, and the second, an unidentified person.

I would like to thank the following for their assistance during the auction, Lary Howard, Vicki Norfleet, John Parks, Jay Sinclair, Alfonso Tercero and Treasurer Joan Wheeler. The treasurer's work continued for the next two days, verifying sales and purchase figures and mailing reimbursement checks to the sellers.
