MARCH BONSAI WORKSHOP

Workshop with Julian Adams Thursday, March 26, 2015 6 – 9 PM at MBG

Julian will put his presentation on black pine into practice with a workshop using black pine. Material for this workshop is available, 7 – 9 year old black pine, acquired from Steve Pilacik of Fuquay Varina, North Carolina. These pine have been repotted into bonsai soil in mid-spring 2014 and allowed to recover for the season. In addition, a collection of 3 year-old black pine seedlings is offered for those who want to develop material from young stock.
