- Mark Field will critique our show on Saturday evening, starting at 6pm
- Allison Correll, Visitor Services & Events Supervisor at MBG, is working with Kurt Smith to make this a pleasurable event.
- This is free to all memebers. Please come!

This meeting was intended to be a relaxed event and an opportunity to examine the MBG bonsai collection.
