10 year celebration of the bonsai collection at Matthaei Gardens

Over 70 people in attendance

Jerry Meislik left a message on how interest was shown to start a permanent bonsai collection at Matthaei ~13 years ago. More funds are needed to keep the collection going.

Jack Sustic mentioned there are too many trees to display. Currently, the bonsai are in 4 different locations. About half of the 125 newly donated trees from Melvyn Goldstein are now at Matthaei in the overflow area. Jack complimented the AABS club in how they bring people in and provide many volunteers.

Jack Wikle, the longest active AABS member, spoke on how he had shown a tree in the 1971 show and then became a member in 1974.

Tony Kolenic who is a newcomer to the collection spoke on how special this month was for the entire bonsai department with all of the activities and celebrations. Currently there are ~60 trees on display at any one time. They are looking to expand the viewing area and are in need of an apprentice to study under Jack Sustic.

Overall, it was a terrific evening with food, drink, and one of the greatest collections of bonsai.
